Your application for the proposed additions, alterations, restoration and rezoning of Farm 733, Bokkierivier, Malmesbury, was tabled at the Built Environment and Landscapes Committee (BELCom) meeting held on 31 January 2018.

DECISION:

1. The Committee decided that the placement of the new tented camp, sunken ablutions facilities and solar panel installation do not negatively affect the historical significance and are therefore approved. The work indicated on drawing 1505/101/01; 1505/102/01; 1505/201/01; 1505/301/01; 1505/401/01; 1505/501/01 and 1505/017/04 to the existing buildings is approved.
2. The Committee is satisfied that the provisions of Section 27 of the NHRA have been met and that the Section 24G application be approved by DEADP.
3. Monthly progress reports to be submitted by the heritage practitioner to the case officer.
4. If any enclosure of the PV array is considered, this must be submitted to HOMS for approval. Any fencing should be visually transparent and not exceed the height of the top of the solar panels.

- **Work may NOT be initiated during this 14 day appeal period.**
- If any archaeological material or evidence of burials is discovered during earth-moving activities all works must be stopped and Heritage Western Cape must be notified immediately.
- This approval does not exonerate the applicant from obtaining any necessary approval from any other applicable statutory authority.
- **An HWC STAMPED PLAN must be present on the site at all times** and must be produced on demand by any heritage inspector, building control official, or any person duly authorized to do so.
- **A copy of this permit must be prominently displayed on site at until the permitted work has been completed**
